It is our honour to report on a year of growth and significant development for World Without Orphans Europe. Yet it has been a year of also rising to serve our partners working directly with Ukrainian children and their parents or carers following the invasion of Ukraine by the Russian troops.



In this, our first published Annual Report, we share key information about our story, information and news from 2022, and the strategy to inspire and support the initiation and nurturing of national 'Without Orphan' Christian movements.

We envisage a world where every child grows up in a safe and loving family. So it has been exciting to see new launches with national Facilitation Teams in Bulgaria and Egypt, building on the experience of Albania Without Orphans in 2021. Already there are examples of:

- Children being reunited with birth families from orphanages in Cairo.*
- Ukrainian families being supported through trauma training and prayer in Bulgaria.
- Families fostering in Albania.

The February announcement of war in Ukraine led to much of our focus being on supporting Ukrainian families and children. You can read about the generous donations, both from individuals and financial partners, which helped fund projects in seven countries. The WWO team maintained regular contact with our friends inside Ukraine with encouragement. We partnered with the global WWO movement to help with distribution of war time parenting tips, and promoting Hope Groups for Ukrainian women. We continue to pray for Ukraine and serve where we can.

In 2023, we invite you to join us to:

- Partner with national leaders to initiate, nurture collaboration and mobilise churches to care for the most vulnerable children in Europe.
- Support those serving Ukrainian refugees, in partnership with national teams and the global WWO movement.
- Facilitate the availability of best practice training through national 'Without Orphans' teams.

This is our story.

Starting in 2008, established movements in Ukraine, Romania, Moldova and the UK have resulted in tens of thousands of children being welcomed into Christian families. New, coordinated 'without orphans' movements have started in Albania, Bulgaria, and Egypt through Europe Without Orphan's work since 2019. Currently 8 countries have teams and coordinated facilitation teams, 12 have active collaboration without formed teams, of which 7 are working with us to develop the movement. We have contact with 4 further countries, at an earlier stage.

World Without Orphans Europe is registered in England and Wales as a non-profit organisation.

WWO Europe works in collaboration with the WWO global team to pursue our common vision, specifically in Europe.

BROADSCALE COLLABORATION

INTERVENTION

PREVENTION

Orphanhood, abuse and vulnerability are avoidable, not inevitable. We promote strategies for an overarching framework for ending violence against children.

OUR 2022 STRATEGY

We have adopted a strategic approach to helping countries to initiate and grow their national Without Orphans movement, using a gardening analogy.

THE GARDENING PLAN

The Nurture Programme is the process by which we identify leaders and teams in a new country with whom we can collaborate. We then support them to create a Facilitation Team and take the first steps towards being a national movement. This involves mentoring, online meetings with the facilitation team, support and vision-casting visits, online and in-person round tables in the country.

Thrive Projects are three-day in-country consultation and planning events which launch national movements. Events are prepared by the Facilitation Team in collaboration with the local team to fit the needs of each nation in the best possible way. The Thrive event helps attendees to understand the best practices in care for vulnerable children, and with that in mind help to shape a way forward through short-term activities and a longer-term development plan.

The Watering Programme is the ongoing support for the national leaders of existing and growing WWO movements in Europe. It includes learning communities, online meetings, mentoring, online and in-person training. At the end of 2022 preparations were underway for a face-to-face event in March 2023 in Sofia, Bulgaria for over 200 'waterers' and 'gardeners' in Europe.



OUR 2022 STRATEGY

UKRAINE APPEAL FUND

In 2022 WWO Europe started the Ukraine Appeal Fund designated to provide aid to Ukrainian families at risk, orphan children, children separated from family or at risk from such separation. Relief funds have been distributed through selected partner organisations with project descriptions on the next page.

The principles on which funding of projects through WWO Europe's Ukraine Appeal Fund is based:

- Focusing on children and families at risk, especially on orphans, foster children, adoptive families, children separated from their families or at risk of becoming separated.
- Addressing the psychological needs of children and those caring directly for them.
- Projects providing for material needs are considered in particularly urgent situations.
- Supporting projects that are building the capacity of communities to care for the children, and where the investment will be multiplied.
- Supporting projects that build on or create collaboration between partners that are addressing the orphan situation in their countries.

	COUNTRY	PROJECT DESCRIPTION
1	Romania	Supported ARFO (Romania Without Orphans) with trauma training, refugee centres, and 130 gift bags for children.
	Moldova	Supported ACMO (Moldova Without Orphans) with refugee centres, 270 food packages, and theraupetic camps for 60 people.
2	Bulgaria	Supported 3 Bulgarian churches to organise a Christmas party for 40 children, paid living costs for refugees, and provided 450 humanitarian aid packages.
	Poland	Supported 2 partners to print 750 sets of Friendship cards and helped organise Play Healing Training & Therapy.
	Slovakia	Supported 2 local partners to provide psychosocial services for 3 months for school children, and funded 10 young people to attend a Christian camp.
	Germany	Supported Ukrainian NGO to cover living costs for vulnerable children without parental care based in Germany.
*	Croatia	Provided humanitarian aid to a family hosting Ukrainians after a fire in their house.

"I really want to say big THANK YOU to help us rebuild the house where we host 6 Ukrainians."


"Thank you for your support. We have been able to provide food packages to Ukrainian families who have been housed with Moldovan families."
